History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: The Milford family settled here in the 1850s, and built the earliest house of local slate and mud in 1858/9, in the Cornish style with rounded corners. The brick house was built in 1878 and the weatherboard in 1918. The original house is now used as a shed.
