## Statement of Significance

Last updated on - December 6, 2006

A nine-storey bank of 1938-39 designed by Meldrum & Noad; representing one of the last uses of the classical revival style traditionally associated with banks in the 1930s, here exemplified in a restrained form on the two street facades of sandstone over a granite plinth and within the main banking chamber. The classification extends to the banking chamber and street facades.
