Summerhill homestead is perhaps the oldest extant homestead in the Craigburn district, an early settled region of north of Melbourne. The homestead is impressively situated on a prominent hilltop. The restrained symmetry of the original Colonial Georgian two storey building is enhanced by the later Tuscan Doric portico and delicate single storey iron and timber verandah. The homestead, with attendant outbuildings, forms an interesting pastoral complex
