Archaeological Significance	Site is archaeologically significant as one of the earliest examples of a sawmill in the Edenhope district likely to contain intact deposits relating to the timber industry.

History

One of the first sawmills in the Edenhope district, started by James Lampard, possibly as early as 1860. The mill had further owners before it was bought by Mr Pahl and removed to his property at Langkoop during the 1940s.
