## Statement of Significance

Last updated on - May 18, 2004

The Former J R Ellingworth's Estate Agency, built in 1911, is of local architectural and historic importance. Featuring a prominent corner oriel window with a "witch's hat" turret, it is a distinctive post-Edwardian design. It is a landmark in the Box Hill shopping centre which is characterised by post-Edwardian structures. J R Ellingworth was the elder son of William Ellingworth, a founder of the Box Hill municipality, and was himself a councillor and Mayor. The designer/builders were the local firm Garrett & Mawson.
