The former Pelaco shirt factory at 27 Gipps Street, Richmond, is significant at the State level both historically and socially. This significance stems from Pelaco's renown as Australia's best-known shirt manufacturer, and as a pioneer of apparel production systems in Australia. Pelaco's two factories on Richmond Hill also made the company a focus of life for seventy-five years. The factory at 27 Gipps Street is the site where time and motion studies were first systematically implemented in the industry. Classified: 17/03/1993
