21 and 23 are Individually Classified. Individual Statement of Significance: A two-storey rendered bluestone house similar to but not identical with its neighbour No 21, built 1854-1868 for H Powell, a Stone Mason.

Classified: 13/11/1975

Group Statement of Significance: Row of 8 two-storey bluestone houses with rendered facades, parapets with simple moldings and six-paned well proportioned windows, numbers 9 and 19 identical, 21 and 23 each similar; currently painted in five varying colours. All built from 1854-1860s for four different owners who, with subsequent early owners and occupants, are representative of Fitzroy's background in business, politics and the theatre.
