A large polychromatic brick building designed by H R Bastow, Chief Architect, Education Department of Victoria and built in 1877-78. The design is similar to the Williamstown School No 1183 although that building was erected in Basalt.

The bell and spire have been removed, the roof has been tiled and the large windows have been altered. The additions at the rear are not included. Classified: 11/12/1975
