History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: According to Flett, the Four Post goldfield was discovered and rushed in 1858. The field continued to be a focus for alluvial miners into the early 1860s: eg., in 1861, the mining register reported that the greater portion of the division's alluvial mining population were still engaged at the Four Post Rush. The field was reported in 1863 as being abandoned, except for Chinese miners.
