Austin Hall & Austin Terraces: Two pairs of single-storey cottages flanking a two-storey building with central clock tower, all in polychrome brickwork with slate roofs and elaborate cast-iron verandah trim, erected 1888 for administration by the Ladies' Benevolent Association. Classified 24/04/1975 See also B3624 Elizabeth Austin Cottages.

Street; Elizabeth Austin Cottages, 8-12a Munday Street and 13-23 Carr Street.
