Statement of Significance

Last updated on - July 26, 2005

An exceptionally large bluestone parish church sixty metres long and dominating the Geelong townscape. The bulk of the nave was completed in 1872 to the design of T A Kelly and the remainder of the building in 1931-7 by C C Kelly. The bluestone spire of the central tower is an unusual feature, the chancel has flying buttresses, and the main facade includes exquisitely traceried rose windows. The interior is spacious, with apsidal chevet chapels, ambulatory, imposing chancel, and stained glass by Ferguson & Urie and Mathieson & Gibson.
