A Gothic church designed by Willilam Wardell in 1863 rather in the manner of Charles Hansom, but later degraded by the rebuilding of the west end after the collapse of the west wall and turret, and now most notable for the magnificent decoration of the chancel (apparently of twentieth century date) with stencilled patterns and seraphim and painted biblical figures as a frieze.
