Statement of Significance

Last updated on - August 12, 2005

Built around 1880, the shops are of local architectural and historic significance. They are among Kyneton's most substantial nineteenth century two storey shops.

The shops provide an appropriate streetscape link between the Kyneton Shire Hall and Post Office and are members of an important group of buildings near the Jennings Street intersection.

Physical Description 1

The shop at no. 125 Mollison Street is a two storey brick facade which was probably originally symmetrical, though the existing 20th century shopfront is asymmetrical. The painted brick facade is framed with rendered pilasters and capped by a parapet and cornice supported on decorative brackets at each end. The first floor facade incorporates three double hung windows, with a cornice detail over the central window.

The shop at no. 127 Mollison Street is also two storey, though its rendered facade is more embellished than its neighbour. At ground level, the original arched residential entrance, with six panelled door, is retained, but the adjacent shopfront is of a later date. The symmetrical upper level facade incorporates three double hung windows, each capped with bracketed cornices. The facade is surmounted by a parapet incorporating a segmental arched pediment, over a decorative stuccoed frieze and cornice.

Both shops have had original verandahs removed.
