A hospital built in 1854/55 with government backing and in use ever since; two -storey bluestone with elaborate yet delicate cast-iron verandah balconies and pedimented entrance.

The hospital formed part of the notabel townscape of Kyneton, an important 19th century highway town. The hospital was a landmark in the town, is prominent in the surrounding landscape and is a particularly early surviving and substantial hospital building.
