The site does not appear to have undergone any later modifications and therefore the entire structure represents one continuous occupation, probably dating to the 1840's.

History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: The site is part of the Campbell brothers' Mt Cole property - the first European settlement in the region. Colin Campbell was a prominent settler, being both a member of parliament and an Honorary Correspondent (distributed rations and supplies to Aborigines). Historical Records attest to Aboriginal people camping around the property throughout the 1840's, 50's and 60's.
