Heritage Inventory History of Site: Middle Creek diggings opened in 1854 with the discovery of the Sardine Lead. New ground was still being found up until the early 1870s. The archaeological evidence shows that the lead was extensively worked, and the main technology used to treat the wash was puddling machines.
