National Australia Bank - 3rd building. The foundation stone was laid on 17 February 1887 by Sir Thomas, the manager of the bank, and the building was completed in 1888. It replaced the earlier building. The architect was Thomas Collins & Bennett and the cost was £40,000. It was replaced by the bank in 1988 by the building now seen and was still above 1988, with the current interior continuing to operate.
