Outstanding size

One of a group of eight trees in a circle around a venerable parent tree. This tree is the tallest of the group and is bifurcated at 36m. The tree has a well formed trunk and canopy and features the distinctive rough stringy bark of the species. The stand is the most southerly occurrence of the species in Victoria.

The tree is located on Ellery Creek walking track, next to the gate 0.5km from Big River Road.
