Rare or localised Outstanding size The largest example within a stand of mature Mountain Ash (*Eucalyptus regnans*), the tree's major interest is its easterly location and mature form. A second tree located further south with a hollow trunk has a girth of 9.3m. Another large stand occurs along Hensleigh Creek Road although these trees are not as large. Both stands represent the most easterly occurrence of the species in Victoria.

The tree is located off Coast Range Road, 1.1km west of the intersection with Cobon Road on the south side.
