A small tree with light coloured leaves and a spreading crown. The species is confined to gullies and rocky slopes in the East Gippsland highlands, the Otways and the Grampians. This tree was the largest observed of few examples located in the Errinundra region. A stand of three trees occurs on the south side of Gunmark Road, 1.3km from the Errinundra Road intersection.

The tree is located 5m west of Rooty Break Track, approximately 20m from Coast Range Road.
