Contribution to the landscape of historic garden  
Outstanding example of species

This almost perfect cone-shaped tree is a dominant feature in the landscape at the eastern end of the impressive stand of conifers which includes *Cedrus atlantica f. glauca*, *Chamaecyparis lawsoniana* and *C. Lawsoniana 'Aurea'*. The tree is the finest example known in cultivation in Victoria despite being multi-trunked near the top. Located up driveway to left.

St Fillans was purchased by Sir James Munro (Premier of Victoria 1890-92) in the late 1880s and the planting is thought to be from this period.
