The Avenue of Honour was established in August 1918 as a memorial to local men who had fought in World War I. The 281 , Dutch Elms (*Ulmus x hollandica*) were planted along the Old Western Highway, beginning at Pearce Street. Planting also includes *Ulmus glabra*. Name plates of individual servicemen are attached to each tree.
