Aesthetic significance

This is an outstanding avenue in the township of Bright; located between Hawthorn and Tyndynder Lanes. These trees make a contribution to the landscape and are well known for autumn colouring. The avenue is a mixed planting of alternating *Quercus palustris* and *Cedrus deodara*. Spacing between plantings is 21 metres. A *Quercus robur* is planted outside No 109.
