Contribution to landscape

This street planting of 17 trees is located between Anderson Street and Gully Creek. It is an avenue of mixed conifers, including *Cedrus deodara* (x9), *Araucaria bidwillii* (x6), and *Pinus nigra var. maritima* (x2). This planting is one of the few examples of conifers used for street planting in Victoria. Conifers were popularly recommended during the 1860s-1870s but fell out of favour as street plantings in the late 1800s and were replaced by deciduous trees.
