This Picconia is located on the south side of the homestead, in a garden that is thought to date from the time the house was built in 1885. This multi-trunked specimen makes an attractive contribution to the unembellished lawn. Picconia excelsa is endemic to Macronesia, occurring on the Canary Islands(Spain) and Madiera(Portugal) and is uncommon in cultivation in Victoria.

This specimen appears to host a bracket fungus.
