## Statement of Significance

Last updated on - July 7, 2008

This six storey brick warehouse, built in 1890, was designed by Twentyman and Askew in association with F G Green for the Melbourne Storage Company. A feature of the facade was the use of four elliptical arches and the various window details on each floor. It was considered to be of architectural importance.. The store was demolished in 1985, in order to erect a multi-storey building.
