Interpretation

Heritage Inventory Interpretation: A low density scatter of mostly hand-made bricks, bluestone blocks, miscellaneous wire and some kitchen artefacts (china ware, dark olive drink bottles and glasses, sheet glass, cast iron stove parts, kitchen utensils, ceramic figurines) are present over much of the hillside below Camp Parade. The datable manufactured material suggests that all this refuse belongs to former 19th century houses which were inhabited during the gold rush. A thorough examination concludes that this material occurs across most of the hillside from the parade to approximately the edge of Fraser Street, in some locations forming small heaps, with no discernible organisational structure. It occurs in small quantities down each of the lane ways, but is most abundant in cleared allotments above the first row of houses on Fraser Street. Artificial mounding, shallow excavation and undulations in surface contour is obvious throughout the hill slope.
