History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: the current owner of the pastoral property on which the hut stands advised it was inhabited by an itinerant, known as Tilley, who was found dead in the hut in the 1940s. It seems probable that the hut was constructed in the 180-90s but this would need to be confirmed with further research, The hut was used as a location site for a scene in the film "The Man from Snowy River".
