History

Smith's Reef had two main periods of activity – Tarrangower Reform Co. (1859-c.1866); and Maldon Smith's Reef Gold Mining Syndicate/Campania Consolidated Gold Mining Syndicate/Golden Bell Consolidated (1900 to c.1904). It appears that only one crushing battery was installed at Smith's Reef, in the first mining period, and that any ore extracted in the second period was crushed at Fenteman's Reef.
