History

History of identified puddler feature (July 2021) - The puddling artefact located at 25 B Foletti Road Vaughan Victoria, is a good example of the Heritage of the Gold Mining activities that exist in Mt Alexander Shire. Several significant sites have already been identified in the immediate area and now are part of the Castlemaine Diggings National Park. The Pennyweight Hill diggings and Strathlodden Sites identified on page 436 of the report NORTH CENTRAL GOLDFIELDS PROJECT HISTORIC MINING SITES IN THE CASTLEMAINE/FRYERS CREEK MINING DIVISIONS (By David Bannear Department of Conservation and Natural Resources) that now form part of the Castlemaine Diggings National Park are within 250 meters of the puddler located at 25 B Foletti Road. It is very likely that this site is connected to the activities chronicled in the report.
