The verandah lace visible on site probably dates from circa 1880

Heritage Inventory History of Site: This site is located on Allotment 16B of Section 5, Parish of Metcalfe. It was first purchased by Henry Carnell on 6/6/1872. Henry was a local Sunday school teacher and the house was used for Sunday night gatherings by the local community (pers. com., Neil Girvan). The house has been moved to

Metcalfe.
