History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: Boundy's Hotel appears on maps from the early 1850s. J. Boundy purchased several allotments in the area during the land sales of 1852-53. J. Boundy, R. Braithewaite and R. Tucker purchased the hotel site on 27/1/1853. A toll bar was shown on the Mt Alexander road at this spot on a map in 1853, as well as two other unidentified buildings which appear to correspond to the hotel and the stables. The hotel appeared on Thomas Turner's goldfield's map of 1861, but it is not on the 1870 goldfield's map of the area. It is not known when the hotel ceased to operate. The toll bar, operated by the Borough of Taradale, closed in 1877. The site of the Lone Star Mining Company, which operated during the 1860s, was opposite the hotel. The hotel presumably catered to the mineworkers and the travellers along Mt Alexander Road. The hotel was probably situated to take advantage of traffic stopping at the toll bar. The property has subsequently been used for farming pursuits.
