#### **History**

Heritage Inventory History of Site: In the late 1930s, the success of the Maxwell Consolidated Company in working a reef on the eastern slope of Doctors Gully caused a revival of interest in other abandoned shafts in the gully. The old Ophir shaft was one of these, which appears to have been worked by the Excelsior Gold Recovery. In 1936 this company were reported as having just completed the erection of an up-to-date battery and cyanide plant.
