History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: Commissioners Reef was opened up in the late 1850s by a Swiss-Italian miner named Vincent Perni. The mine was first worked as an open cut and later by shaft mining. The latter type of mining commenced in 1859, when the Cosmopolitan Company (a Clunes based mining company) obtained a good prospect from the reef and installed machinery for underground mining.
