Heritage Inventory History of Site: The first significant mining venture on Bells Reef appears to have commenced in 1880. The mining register reported December 1880 that the Bell's Quartz Company, Black Jack's, would soon have their battery ready. The register also mentions in his next quarterly report that the company were raising quartz from Bell's Reef.
