Heritage Inventory History of Site: German Reef experienced considerable activity during the early 1860s and appears to have been treated as two distinct reefs, namely "Old German" and "New German". Stamping machinery appears to have been installed on both reefs. 1860 Old German Reef, site for machinery dam and tramway has been granted. 1861 New German Reef purchasers have brought. New German Reef, Cuthbert and Co., are busy erecting their battery near the Yandoit Creek ... tramway of upwards of 1,000ft.
