# History

Heritage Inventory History of Site: The Department of Mines Annual Report for 1903 records that Bruce's No. 1 North G. M. Company had done a considerable amount of prospecting for the year, sunk their shaft to a depth of 450 feet, and that their mine was well equipped with winding, pumping and crushing machinery. Presumably this is a miss spelling of Bryce.
