Lost in a storm whilst salvaging the Kakariki. Two men lost with the sinking.

VHR history

The barge was lost during salvage operations on the Kakiriki in November 1940. Mr AE Geddes was contracted to raise the Kakariki from near the Gellibrand pile-light. A storm swept the barge from its moorings and it sank with its £2000 of salvage equipment on board.

The barge had sunk twice before, most recently after storms in October 1940.

In January 1941 the barge had still not been recovered, and attempts were planned to see if the two missing watchmen were trapped on board.
