Vessel supposed to have foundered in Hobsons Bay in July 1873, although registry kept open until 13 Dec. 1875 in the hope that the wreck would turn up. It was never found. (UID52) Purchased by Holymans in 1861 from James Cartledge, schoolmaster. Sold 1872. Its route had been around NW coast of Tasmania. (The Holyman story)
