D. McLennan - Steel Steam Dredge built in Leyden, Holland in 1912. Purchased by the Melbourne Harbour Trust and brought into commission in 1925. The dredge was capable of dredging to 59 feet and it worked on various dredging projects within the port until it was condemned in 1949. After being stripped of all items of value it was scuttled in the Ships Graveyard, Barwon Heads, 1949 (Ryan, Taylor and Whitmore 2009:47).
