VHR history

After the 16 metre scallop boat stranded, it took rescuers 2-1/2 hours to get the two fishermen off the boat. Loney gives two dates for loss of vessel: 1972 and 1973. Ferrier's date - 2 Nov. 1972 - could not be confirmed in any report in the Geelong Advertiser or the Melbourne Sun of the time but Huggins confirmed Ferrier's date from Queenscliffe Lifeboat Preservation Society records.
