### **Cause of loss**

After conversion to a barge it was swept from its moorings in the Snowy River and washed out to sea, then driven ashore

### **VHR history**

The paddle steamer Lady of the Lake stranded on the Snowy River bar in 1880 and was declared a total wreck. The hull was salvaged and used as a barge on the river. During floods in 1893, it was swept out to sea over the river bar and lost.
