Flares were sighted by residents and surf fishermen. A rescue launch manned by the postmaster put to sea. One crew member was found on Tullaberga Island and the other two were found in a liferaft between Tullaberga and Gabo Islands. The Moana was forced to seek shelter by huge seas. The crew mistook Gabo Light for Eden light and stayed too close to rocks, and were driven ashore.
