Register closed with endorsement 'foundered about 1869' [As Red Jacket was a barge, it very likely was lost in Port Phillip.] The vessel, variously referred to as a barge or lighter, docked in the Yarra on 24 January 1870 - the last located reference. Extant Geelong and Melbourne port records show that it operated in the Bay from Dec.1856.
