VHR history

The schooner Rosedale, bound from Melbourne to the Gippsland Lakes, was lost on the Lakes bar in March 1872. Wrecked 4 km east of the entrance. The Rosedale was blown into fragments by a Government diver on 13th March 1880 and portions of hull have appeared along the beach.
