VHR history

Heavy seas caused the barque Suffolk to lose its rudder off the Gippsland coast. The crew constructed a jury rudder, but the vessel was almost unmanageable. The SS Leura attempted to tow the Suffolk but the line parted. Being close to land and with an impending gale, the barque was abandoned off Ram Head.
