"The ketch Teaser, from Melbourne to Queenscliff with a cargo of fencing material for the railway line, got ashore this morning on the east bank of Cole's channel, and is likely to become a total wreck, the port side showing signs of giving way, and the deck being submerged at high water. The crew were taken off and landed at Point Edward, near St. Leonard's."
