Statement of significance

<p>Due to lack of information it is difficult to assess the vessels historical significance. Assessing archaeological significance is also difficult due to it being scuttled. It may be significant as a representative of a type of vessel, a steel screw steamer constructed in the early 20th century depending on the amount of intact material remaining.</p>

VHR history

Steel dredge - After 51 years of service, the steam powered dredge Beverwijk 19 was towed through the Heads and scuttled in the Ships Graveyard.
