# Statement of significance

Due to lack of information it is difficult to assess the vessels historical significance. Assessing archaeological significance is also difficult due to it being scuttled. It may be significant as a representative of a type of vessel, a steel screw steamer constructed in the early 20th century depending on the amount of intact material remaining.

# **VHR** history

Steel dredge - After 51 years of service, the steam powered dredge Beverwijk 19 was towed through the Heads and scuttled in the Ships Graveyard.
