# **VHR** history

Before the construction of a rail link between Orbost and Melbourne, produce was sent by small sailing craft which had to cross the bar of the Snowy River at Marlo. One such vessel was the ketch Wongrabell which stranded on the bar in 1912 and became a total wreck.
